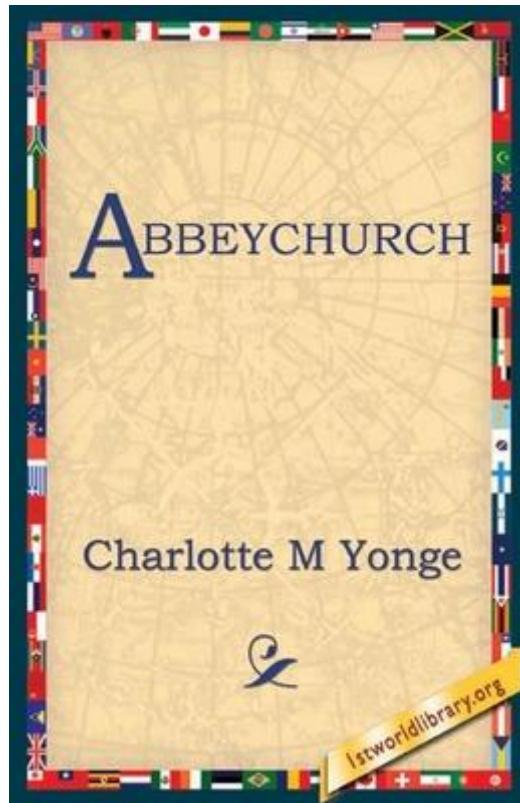


Abbeychurch - Charlotte M. Yonge
