Baseball fans should check out "Ernie Shore" -- a fascinating and true story from 1917 when the Boston Red Sox were 'defending World Champions'! Kenny's relative was a pitcher and had an amazing game against the Senators that ended up in the record books. Gary Owen's layered guitars melt all over "Where Feelings Go" and add subtle texture to "Ogburn Avenue" and "Writing On the Wall" without overpowering either song. Steve Samosky's bass meanders all over these songs giving them an interesting depth. Ian Schreier does double duty by engineering all but 3 songs -- the 3 he plays drums on! And he does a fine job in both departments. Margaret White -- from the band, Regina Hexaphone, etc -- does some fine fiddling throughout Ernie Shore, Cryin', and Miserable Cat. Carla Burgess adds the perfect touch of percussion and backup vocals on several songs. There's so much to say about this album!
