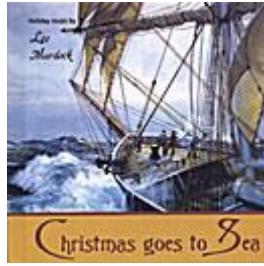


## Mp3 Lee Murdock - Christmas Goes To Sea

In a further cross-pollination of art and music, three of these tunes are poems, set to music by Lee Murdock. Bell Buoy on Christmas Day, by Charles Francis Richardson, 1888 (He was a lighthouse keeper along the Maine coast). Blessed Christmas Morn, by Robert Louis Stevenson (originally published by Stevenson as "Christmas at Sea") Christmas Goes to Sea, by Rachel Field, 1941 One other poem, A Sailor's Carol, was set to music by Gordon Bok.
