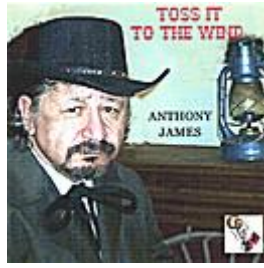


Mp3 Anthony James - Toss It To The Wind
