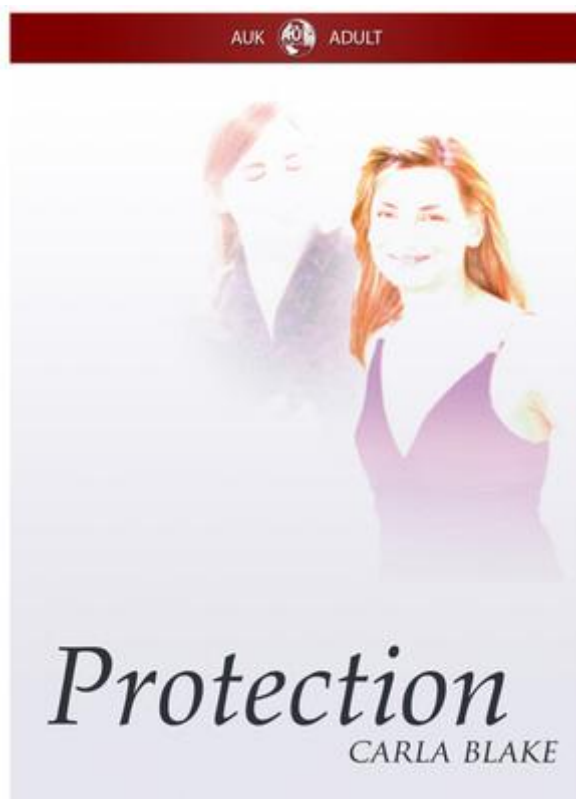


Protection: An Erotic Lesbian Love Thriller - Carla Blake
