


Mp3 Wood, Wind & Wire - Take Me Back

But with their newest recording, "Take Me Back", a clear path has emerged. "Folk" music is what most people would call it. I call it GOOD music, very good music. The Cd is a lovely mix of classic tunes and stand out original compositions. The production is seamless and smooth, uncluttered by bells and whistles, and allows the beauty of the lyrics and melodies to be heard. The cover art, designed by the artists themselves, reflects the content of the recording as a whole and is interesting and eye-catching. Many voices have been said to be 'angelic' but Karen Yearwood's is one that epitomizes that descriptive. Her clear delivery is a treat and always conveys the emotion behind the lyric. Husband Daryl's smooth baritone seems to caress the words and is so easily listened to that, even on a first play of the cd, feels familiar and comforting. These two distinctly different voices, amazingly, blend perfectly, creating a warm and rich harmony very pleasing to the ear. Musically, the accompaniment is sparse and simple, yet gracefully accented by Daryl's hammered dulcimer and Karen's bowed psaltry. In this day and age where more is often considered to be better, the simplicity of this recording is a very pleasant change of pace and can only be described as beautiful. Overall, I find "Take Me Back" to be thoroughly enjoyable and certainly representative of folk music at its finest.
