The Voices Of Victory. Gene began to travel around that time, singing the Gospel in small churches in California. He was know from the begining for his smooth powerful singing style. A style acquired by listening to all the great Gospel singers of the 40's through 60's on their 78's,45's and 331/3's. At the age of 17, while attending a gathering of musicans and singers at a home in Los Angeles. The Revs. Andre'and Sondra Crouch (personel friends of his) asked him to sing. Andre' played the piano. And the rest is history. Gene was asked to be part of the Famous James Cleveland Singers. And within the week, he, without rehearsel began what was to become an extended tour throughout the US. Appearing with all the greats of the day. Mahalia Jackson, Doris Akers, The Famous Caravans, The Gospel Harmonettes, The Staple Singers, The Ward Singers, The Davis Sisters, The Roberta Martin Singers. Many of the great choirs also. Like The Angelic Choir, The Voices Of Tabernacle and many others. He has appeared both as a Cleveland singer and a solo artist at the world famous Apollo Theater and many of the other prestigious venus across this country. He has also been priviliged to appear in a one time tour of five countries in Europe. Gene has recieved awards from both the Urban League and The NAACP.2005 brought him a Gospel Pioneer Award..given by the world famous Oakland Interfaith Gospel Choir and recogniction by The Gospel Music Workshop Of America.. Founded

by the late Rev. James Cleveland, at their Milwaukee Workshop. Forty years have passed, since his first recording experience. Gene, is no longer a boy. He has been featured over the years on six albums. The first as a Cleveland Singer "Heaven That Will Be Good Enough For Me" on the Savoy Label."What Color Is God" Checker Records, "As Unto The Lord"and"If You Trust In The Lord"Camella Records.Previous to this new project, a Live CD "The Only Hope We Have" with the late Miss Cassietta George of the Legendary Caravans. This project "A Light To This World" is by far his most heart felt sharing.
