His playing features a wonderful mixture of fierce grooving pizzicato and olympic style bowing, the like of which the band hasnt yet seen, and which adds a new and fantastic dimension so crucial to the music. Bronislav Vanya Krawczyk Vanja is one of the most accomplished accordionists to come out of Poland in recent years. He is self taught and was touring Poland playing concerts, parties, weddings etc before he was invited to come and play in the UK in 1995. Luke Carver Goss has performed with Szapora since 1998. He also works with violinist Oli Wilson-Dickson in the duo 'Fidaddle', who are currently playing at

folk festivals around Britain. Oliver Wilson-Dickson has been studying the violin since the age of six. Born into a family of musicians, he was raised on a diet of traditional, world, jazz and contemporary music and studied music at the University of York. Dylan Fowler first came to prominence in the Miller/Fowler Latin Jazz Guitar Duo in the early eighties. In January 1998 Fowler was invited to join the group Szapora. Mirza Halilovic is an actor and musician born in Sarajevo and who studied at The Academie of Theatre, Film TV in Sarajevo. Mirza has lived in France since 1995.
