The choir experience was an enriching and rewarding one with the release of two CDs. Never Failed Me Yet won an ECMA for BEST GOSPEL BLUES ARTISTS in 1996. Eileen Joyce featured as a soloist in the two seasons of CBC TVs HALLELUJAH, with its 26 episodes still playing in syndication on Vision TV. The choir has performed with The Holmes Brothers, Mavis Staples Lennie Gallant, Martha Reeves and many more. She has been the producer and artistic director of her own annual show LADIES IN BLUE for the past seven years. As an Early Childhood Educator, Eileens love of children has always contributed to her lifelong passion for developing and

teaching music and drama classes for young children. She enjoys creating original compositions, including an interactive musical play for school aged children Ugga and the Music. She is also working on her first childrens cd to accompany some of her childrens books. Eileen will be touring to support the release of her new cd Bluesman in 2007. The cd is rounded out with wonderful songs that Eileen and Bill composed such as Every Shade of Blue an R&B soon to be classic and Why do you Look so Good, a rocking blues tune that is full of fun. Joined once again by a great band Danny Sutherland on bass, Bill Harvey on piano Scott Ferguson on drums, George Antoiniak and Garret Mason on guitar, her daughter Nicole Ouellete and Melanie Donnely on back up vocals and produced at Ferguson Music Production This most recent effort was officially released in Aug and will hit the market by Oct 10 2006. Eileens, NO MORE BLUE TEARS is true to the music she loves; Jazz, Blues and R&B. Featuring top Atlantic Canadian musicians and special guests Charlie ACourt and Woody Woods, her original material brings a fresh sound to the Maritime scene.
