He also entered the film scoring program under the distinguished tutelage of Charles Bernstein and Steven Scott Smalley. In addition, he studied Orchestra conducting with Donald Neuen, artistic director of the Angeles Chorale. Gerard received his UCLA diploma in 2001. Gerard's life is full, not only with his music, but with his philanthropic contributions as well. He has played for charitable events and fund raisers including: The American Heart Association, the National Foundation for AIDS Research, Children's Hospital of Los Angeles and Orange County, and the Long Beach Veterans Hospital.
