Well known around his home for his solo performances as well as his work as principle songwriter and lead guitarist of the band 7/10 Split, Paine just released his debut solo album on Park Bench Records. In November 2001, one of his songs, "Once in a While," captured first place in the Youth Division of the Alaska Public Radio Network song of the year contest. The competition drew over 225 songwriters statewide, with judges in Anchorage, Juneau, and Fairbanks. As a result, Paine and his band performed at the Song of the Year Concert held at the Alaska Center for Performing Arts.
