Kutay has been a student of African Drumming since the age of 5. He is a Music Director and a Costume Designer. Before co-founding Rakaba with Fanta, he was the Musical Director of The Fritong Players. Kutay was a pannist with Atlanta's Pan People Steel Band, a percussionist and vocalist with Oosadebe International Nigerian Band, co-founder and lead vocalist for Atlanta's Sierra Soucous Band, and principle performer for the Sierra Leon National Dance Troup.
