Shortly thereafter, it was produced at the Millbrook Playhouse in Pennsylvania and once again at The 2005 New York International Fringe Festival where it won Outstanding Music and Lyrics! Dante also wrote the book and lyrics to Radiant Ruby, a new family musical that was produced at the Vital Theatre Company in the Fall of 2005. As a performer, Dante is currently touring the United States and Canada in Disney's "High School Musical."
