Together, the members of Smithfield Fair create a dynamic atmosphere to transport listeners through time and space, away from their daily concerns and deposit them on safer ground with a feeling of hopefulness. Audiences consistently comment on the enormous sound the quartet achieves and the power and depth of the musical presentation. Reviewers have noted the groups live shows exhibit influences of folk, jazz, swing, pop, and Celtic, while remaining a cohesively

warm whole. Smithfield Fairs active touring schedule includes a wide variety of carefully selected concerts, acoustic music festivals, house concerts and coffeehouses, but regardless of venue, the group preserves an intimate relationship with audiences. Smithfield Fair has built a strong following and continues to garner high critical praise for its music and presentation. The group has shared stages with a veritable whos who of American roots and Celtic musics finest.
