

Ira is Blackfoot from the Piikani Nation located at Brocket in Southern Alberta, Canada. Iras music reflects his profession as an educator of Aboriginal awareness and understanding. His songs tell stories of gaining strength from cultural identity in hopes of reaching and instilling pride in Aboriginal youth. Ira Provost is a fantastic performer and singer/songwriter. He presents a great perspective in his presentations of his original material as well as his cover material. In the last 17 years Ira has had the opportunity to record demo material with several different groups including (Mountain Song, Strayhorse, Sundog, and Ira Rudy); Ira has performed with 5 country/rock musical bands including (Redwood, Ivory Black, Strayhorse, Sundog and Rudz Crew) that included performances throughout Northern and Southern Alberta, British Columbia, Saskatchewan and various states in the U.S.A. Ira has also performed as a solo musician numerous times and has also been involved in the music industry as a promoter, manager, consultant for artistic aboriginal talent throughout Southern Alberta. Cultural Communication Apart from his musical talents Ira has extensive work experience in cultural awareness implementing cross cultural communication models through programming. Ira worked as an interpretive guide, supervisor, director and now coordinator relating to cultural education programs. This gives Ira a holistic understanding of expert systems pertaining to both Western and Aboriginal learning environments. Ira also has managerial education obtained from Lethbridge College and worked extensively with major academic institutions and community agencies. Together with his musical talents, education, song writing ability and professional career, Ira has demonstrated the qualities of an outstanding leader, promoter and role model for music, culture and education. Blackfoot Sky works to incorporate all of these elements for greater understanding and a better relationship between Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal peoples alike.
