In the course of nine years, the 22 year-old Mansfield OH, native has experienced a lot and has compiled it into his debut release, Cavalcade, under the project name, Tintern Abbey. Tintern Abbey echoes the sounds of male singer/songwriters, with John Mayer immediately coming to mind. Allen also refers to music his parents listened to, such as Phil Keaggy and Glass Harp, as he was growing up. It's a comparison Allen regards as a compliment. If anything, Allen should be applauded for his focus on the songs he's released so far, replete with well-orchestrated arrangements coupled with acoustic guitar and Allen's vocals at the forefront. "It's an 11-song walk through of my life, particularly in the last two years," Rob Allen says of

Cavalcade. "I embellish somewhat because you can make a good song great when you step out of your skin for a little bit. There are a lot of ups and downs and the cd follows them." In the live setting, Allen said to expect a traditional band setup, with room for some improvisation. Tintern Abbey includes his brother, Josh Allen, as well as drummer Lee Penn, musician Jonathan Hape, violinist Megan Oswalt, and cello/bassist Kyle Murphy. "When you have a band name, it tends to open up more avenues," Allen said.
