Critically Acclaimed in only a few months of his release, his staccato sound landed him the headlining performance during the half-show of The Ohio Nike Basketball Game, December 5th 2003 at Dominican college in Columbus, Ohio. He also stole the show at the Come 2 Go Club February 28th, 2004 that brought over 500 fans to the event. In May 2004 Rudy was introduced to Indy's own UrbanLink Music Group and has begun working on his new full-length debut LP, "For The Love Of..." With this new project Rudy is a little different. He's older. Wiser. More perceptive. And more aware of what he wants to do and what he needs to do. "This time around, I know it's okay to dream and have fun. But I also learned that after cloud nine clears; I better have my business in mind. At
