Creek, The Baltic in Pt. Richmond, Plant 51 in San Jose, held weekly gigs at the Gold Coast Grill, and a myriad of private parties and events. Their funky ingenuity combined with their lovingly optimistic, yet realistic vision for the future, has built a groovin'-good-times feel-good vibe attracting a growing collective of fashion designers, painters, graphic artists, web-designers, dancers, film-makers, djs, other musicians, fans and friends from San Francisco's youthful adult sector who are bent on contributing to the growth and momentum of FUNKLOGIC's music.
