On November 19, 1993, the Celebration Mass Choir officially adopted the name Praise, Honour and Glory, with reference to 1 Peter 1:7. Besides cities in Tennessee, the group has traveled to Virginia, Ohio and South Carolina performing concerts. In July 2000, Praise, Honour and Glory released its first recording, a super single with the project name "Our Praise." In June 2002, Praise, Honour and Glory shared its music ministry on the island of Sicily in Italy. Praise, Honour and Glory is a Christian ministry with an outreach to all who would hear the Word of God through their music ministry. The group has supported Knoxville and surrounding communities by involvement in projects such as Habitat for Humanity, The Soup Kitchen, Christmas Angel Trees, Crutcher Memorial Youth Enrichment Center, International 4H, Children's Defense Fund, and the Knoxville Museum of Art, to name a few. Presently, the choir's membership includes persons from fifteen churches in five cities and at least five denominations.
