A self-taught guitar player, Martin first picked up the guitar when he was 15, but eventually pushed it aside in favor of a hockey stick throughout high school. Martin recently returned to Philadelphia after a two-year stint in Boston, a notoriously successful market for igniting the careers of budding singer-songwriters.
