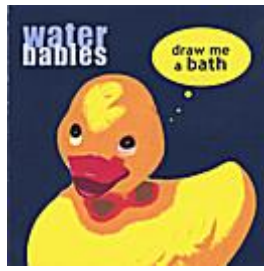

They draw inspiration from each other, from the audience, from the atmosphere of the room, and from their musical forefathers, groups like Herbie Hancock's Headhunters, Miles Davis' Bitches Brew band, Maceo Parker, and Medeski, Martin Wood. Above all, Water Babies never lose their main focus: To deliver the most distinguished and funky improv grooves and to share the joy that comes from creating magic in each moment.
