Traveling In The Trunk Of A Car Americana / Rock song with slow blues undertones welded to a suspense story- "Well I woke up in the trunk of a car, took a blackjack right on my head If I don't get out of here fast, pretty soon I might be dead She slipped me a mickey, I bought her a drink Couldn't stand up, could not even speak Two gorillas in suits dragged me outside Hit me on the head and then we went for a ride She kept my briefcase with the money inside" 2. The Viking War Song Acoustic folk song about vikings, nice guitar accompaniment by Krassy Halatchev "It's blood and booty and the battle-axe and Anglo Saxon women" 3. Iron Wheels Powerful guitar driven Americana with fantastic spontaneous guitar outro by Krassy Halatchev. Some good ole boys decide to rob a Vegas Casino. They've got a hideout in the mountains and a plan. What could go wrong? This song has the flavor of a Humphrey Bogart / Robert Mitchum "Film Noire" gangster movie- "We drove down to Las Vegas and we borrowed a Casino money truck" 4. The Werewolf Of Paris Slow Roadhouse Rock. The centuries-spanning epic tale of the Werewolf of Paris- "Hear that howl the werewolf's on the prowl and there's blood on the moon tonight" 5. Vampire Man Jazzy Rock Ballad with a moody night-time atmosphere and vocals that pierce through the shadows. Lyrical story of the Vampire Man. Haunting orchestration- "I fly through the night on leather wings Feeling more alive than I've ever been Look at the people on the streets down below Afraid of their shadows and what they don't know But I ride through the clouds in the empire of the night I hunt my food and drink and take what's mine by right

The fog-covered water by the canal Where you don't walk alone, always with a pal Cause I am the vampire man" 6. Sheila Does Not Love Him Anymore Jazzy love song with exotic "Greenwich Village" coffee house atmosphere. Peppery guitar, driving beat and "Vegas style" vocals. 7. Fighting With A Madman On Top Of A Train Bluesey Americana adventure song about how NOT to spend a Saturday night- "Yeah I'm a-fightin' with a madman on top of a train" 8. Come Back To Me Darling Tender bittersweet love ballad with warm piano accompaniment by Laurie Gordon- "And we shared so much love... Don't you miss me?" 9. Bottle Man Surreal fantasy Folk song with a slow beat. Strange adventure story about a man who crosses a wizard and gets trapped in a ship inside a bottle on the wall. Does he ever escape? "I went to arrest the wizard but he touched his magic ring The room disappeared and I'm standing on the deck of the mighty River Queen She's a sailing ship in a bottle, no water anywhere in sight Just light and shadows and a sky of glass and a cork that's on too tight" 10. Walk Through The Fire Urban song with caffeine-crazed "Islands" back-up vocals- "Get you out of that bad position Cause I'm a man on a mission A real true love magician" 11. Roman Holiday Lively rousing Europop science fiction. Our hero gets stuck in a time-traveling UFO- "The flying saucer went down in the Bay of Naples, I was part of the recovery team The mini-sub took us down right to the door, we entered and what did we see Women in glass tubes hangin' on the wall, naked and in deep freeze Nobody else in that big dark room, the lights were glowin' blue and green" 12. I Do Love You Tender, romantic ballad. Some country twangin' guitar and 40's / 50's crooner vocals- "Dancing in the moonlight on an ocean cruise Swimming in a sunshine tropical lagoon Songs of love in the air for me and you Your lips are calling, I can't refuse" 13. Get It On Tonight Sexy, grooving Urban love song. Intimate vocals. Bouncy street-techno arrangements. Intoxicating... "Yeah I take you to a nice big restaurant Some juicy steaks and drinkin' now you're really feelin'strong I kiss you and you laugh at one of my jokes Walk in the rain man we get soaked Then I take you for a drive right down to the riverside Makin' love in the waves in the night We gonna get it on tonight" 14. Mary Was A Stripper Biker Roadhouse Rock. Rough raw vocals, powerful thumpin' guitar and bawdy lyrics keep this song movin'- "Take it off, take it off" 15. Hey Bounty Hunter Alt. Country Western. Classic story of betrayal revenge. Jazzy funky orchestration- "You killed her father and blamed it on me Sent me to rot in the penitentiary Then you married her and gave her your name While five years in a cell, hard labour each day Now you hunt men down and bring them in To swing in the breeze while you drink your gin But I'm out and I'm free and I sent you a note To meet me one-on-one in the city of ghosts" 16. Black
