Soubly ("Soo-blee"), like so many other people, is balancing his artistic work against a demanding, full-time IT manager's job at one of the Big Three auto companies. David's works like "Spun Glass" and "Blessings" are invitations into the most intimate areas of his soul. He offers them to the world fully aware that the essence of improvisation dictates that a certain amount of roughness must attend the pieces. It is an intensely private and humbling experience to seat oneself before the piano without any idea at all as to what will be produced. For every piece that makes its way to the CD, another 10 or more have hit the cutting room floor. Even so, these pieces have been captured in a state of evolution. They are in the process of becoming. Other artists may hear, and respond to, melodies that are being birthed. And any serious listener will hear the nascent promise in each melody. But beyond the music is the writing. David has been exploring complex and jagged themes that underpin our world, and he's been writing all kinds of things for the past 30 years. His novel, "Santa, CEO," is a big and bold satire on Christmas, Santa's multinational operations, Wall Street expectations, and the all-consuming appetite that makes up our modern, investor-laden world. In addition to "Santa," David has written works as diverse as "The Miracle Fountain," a story exploring the presence of miracles in everyday actions undertaken by ordinary folk; "Summerdance," a journey from innocence to experience told from the point of view of an eleven-year-old boy growing up in 1960's Detroit; and "The Soul Broker," an outrageous foray into the essence of good and evil, featuring among other things the story of the Flood told from the Devil's point of

view. Through his CD's, David invites listeners to experience his gentle world view, in the hope that these simple melodies will provide welcome relief from the challenges of the day.
