After two years with the group, he took a leave of absence and moved to Middlesboro, Kentucky where the Lord put him under the ministry of a highly anointed minister, Bishop Joseph Glover, who encouraged him to use his gift of music for the glory of God. In October 2002, R.G. met James Ford of Youngstown, Ohio, who provided him the opportunity to use his gift and reach his goal. In December of that year, R.G. began work on his first CD, The Project. In May 2004 R.G. won the American Gospel Music Award for the Best Male Vocalist, and he also appeared on Bobby Jones New Artist Showcase on the Word network. R.G. would like to thank the people that encouraged him to continue to sing for Christ.
