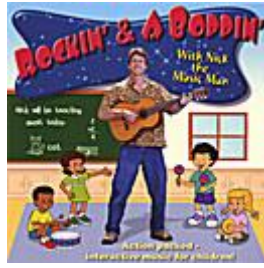

All of our teachers play musical instruments and come to each classroom session equipped with various rhythm instruments, songs, action stories, movement activities, and multicultural experiences for the children. The key to the success of our program is having children actively involved and engaged during each class session. We use guitar accompaniment, and the children play percussion instruments, learn basic music notation, develop a sense of rhythm and and participate in various movement activities. We use songs and activities from various world cultures such as Africa, South America, Asia and others. The songs that we use involve movement and are interactive in nature. The percussion instruments that we use are hand made and imported from Africa and other countries. These instruments are part of every session and an integral part of the childrens
