After the disbandment of Joe Buck, Williams began penning new material for a solo effort that tapped into a variety of influencesThe Velvet Underground, The Replacements, John Prine, and so forth. Recorded in the pre-digital era at Mike Hearsts (One Ring Zero) 8-track home studio in Richmond, VA, the project was titled Function over Fashion for the simplicity of the material and the way in which it was recorded. Several local music friends joined in some of the sessions and The Boring Normals were born. Function over Fashion was re-mastered and re-released in August of 2006. The Boring Normals are currently finishing work on a new full-length CD recorded with Chris Seger at Brevity Studio. The new disc, tentatively titled When I Grow Down is set for an October 06 release.
