Raised 4 children who have provided numerous grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Until recently, I worked for the Veterans Administration. Started writing songs in Spring of 2007 as the result of encouragement from Kimberly Moran of the NH Rock Bottom Band. "The Heart Commits Treason" was selected as the winner, in the Country genre, for the month of January 2009, in the Song Of The Year Contest Currently, I live in Hartland, Vermont and work on my lyrics thanks to the encouragement of a very special lady, Cindy May (Day) Wilkesman, who has partnered with me to publish this, my first album. Please note that I am a writer, not a singer. While the

artists on these songs do a great job, I hope to one day have my songs picked up by well known stars and performed.
