She is a long distance runner, loves playing in large bodies of water, and has a knack for languages and a passion for learning. She writes when she feels like it, which is pretty often, and has spent a lot of hours alone taking her guitar playing in its own choppy direction. The quirky chop of Kristin's guitar weaves its way under, over, and around the peculiar beauty of her voice and the virtuosity of her band, which consists of electric guitarist Steve Schuster and violinist Liza Villarreal. Steve Schuster is a classically trained guitarist with an ear for all musical styles and impeccable focus when performing. He is the talented, silent type who expresses mountain ranges of meaning through his instrument. Liza Villarreal is ebullient on stage and breathes unique life into the classical violin. She also plays some mean percussion instruments. The three of them are attempting to take over the world one venue at a time.
