Although most of her formal musical training is in Classical violin, Laura has also studied Irish fiddle and Baroque violin. Her violin recordings are included in the discography of the Anthology of Baroque Music published by W. W. Norton. Along with her husband Dennis, Laura directs the St. Louis School of Music and teaches violin, fiddle, and ocarina. Dennis Yeh, Violin Dennis has performed numerous recitals in the United States and Australia and many of his performances have been nationally broadcast in Australia. He has also performed as a soloist with the Sydney Symphony Orchestra in Sydney, Australia. Dennis pursued his musical training at the Sydney Conservatorium, Indiana University, and the University of Illinois and has three degrees in violin performance, including a Doctorate of Musical Arts.
