About the band: Wild Mercy is an Indianapolis-based eclectic Celtic band consisting of Jen Midkiff, Debbie Gates, Sally Childs-Helton and Barry Childs-Helton. "But what do you play?" the discerning listener asks. We could tell you it's "neo-Celtic-powered post-industrial electro-acoustic folk-rock with jazz blues, and world influences."
