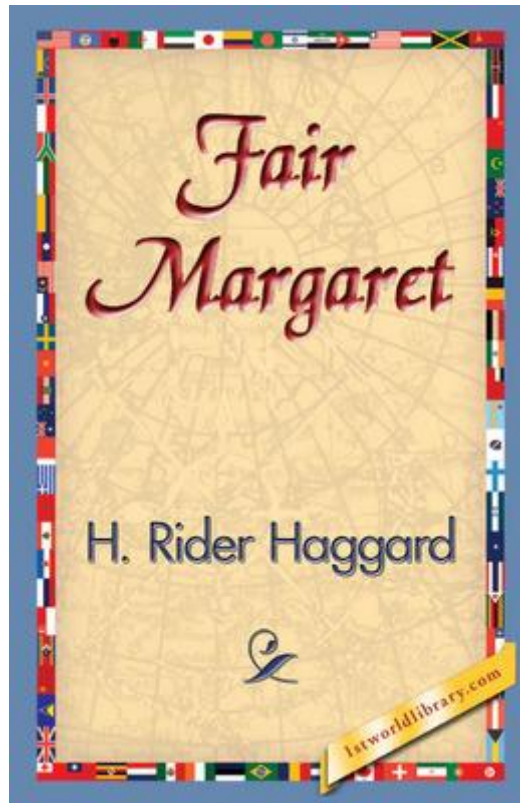


Fair Margaret - H. Rider Haggard
